The council can now fill vacancies by cooption, which is a process whereby the council considers applications from interested persons and can then select someone to fill the position.

- Would you have time and or expertise which could benefit Foston?
- Would you want to make a difference to all those around you?
- Are you concerned about your local area and want to represent the views of Foston residents?

There will be some training which is usually online these days and some will be in person depending on your interests. You will need to attend 6 Parish Council meeting per year plus the odd additional meeting and the Annual Parish Meeting.

#### **Scam Emails**

Have you spotted a suspicious email? Report it to Suspicious Email Reporting Service (SERS) The message might be from a company you don't normally receive communications from, or someone you do not know. You may just have a hunch that the email is not quite right. If you are suspicious, you should always report it.

So if and when you receive an email which you are not quite sure about, forward it to:

<u>report@phishing.gov.uk</u>. It is a good idea to have this email address in your email address book so it will only take seconds to forward any spam on to SERS.

Your report of a phishing email will help Action Fraud to act quickly, protecting many more people from being affected.
