Community Orchard



Lincolnshire County Council and South Kesteven District Council, have been awarded funding from Defra's Coronation Living Heritage Fund. For the creation of mini orchards in the county. We have been awarded enough for ten fruit trees.

All schemes are scored according to their wildlife and landscape benefits and proposed maintenance plan. We applied for ten fruit

trees of various kinds including pears, apples and plums and they have been planted in the Churchyard on the Church Street side. The projects will create new community orchards and micro woodlands in England
