# New Councillors and this year's uncontested election

This year's Parish Council elections have already been decided because we have had an uncontested election. This is because only 5 names have been put forward for 7 council seats. We still have two vacancies so if anybody is interested in becoming a Parish Councillor for Foston please talk to Christina as she is looking for interested Foston

residents wanting to make a difference within the Village.

#### **District Council Elections**

Paul and Jane Wood have been our independent local district Councillors and they will be standing again this year. They have both been very supportive over the previous 4 years.

Jane gave Foston £600 to go towards our Defibrillator located on the wall of the Village Hall. The Parish Council applied for a grant from the Lottery, Awards for All to pay for the balance of the device. Defibrillators work out at around £1600 to £2000+ and they are an essential piece of kit for the village because we are so far away from the Ambulance stations.

# **Newark Community First Aid training**

In January the Newark Community First Aid training team came along to Foston and gave us a brilliant training session on first aid and defibrillator use.



We are due to have another session within the next few months and it is vitally important that everybody is familiar with the use of this potentially lifesaving piece of equipment.

# Replacement Gorrie/Sports Hall

Unfortunately we have to rethink the replacement building on the playing field due to spiralling financial costs for running such a development, as well as financing it.
