Defibrillators

We now have two defibrillators in Foston so please find time to watch the video on how to use a defibrillator in the link below.

The defibrillator will guide you through the process with audible instructions. However it is very helpful to have prior knowledge and be aware of how the defibrillator works, even though it does have diagrams and vocal instructions on how to use it.

You never know when you may be called upon to use a defibrillator and you may save somebody's life one day. If you already have some knowledge it will make using a defibrillator considerable easier.

Up-date of the Parish Plan 2015

The most favoured facility for funding was a footpath on Marshall Way. Improvements to the playing fields and a foot bridge over the A1 were the most important improvements required. Closed circuit TV (CCTV) was not well supported in 2007. Since then there has been an increased interest and enthusiasm for CCTV. In 2015, 67% of respondents, to a questionnaire would support the provision of a CCTV system of cameras on the three entrances to the village and on the Playing Field play area at the bottom of Chapel Lane.

Current initiatives underway

Scout Hut/Sports Hall on the playing field is at the top of our list of priorities. There was a footballer's hut see photograph below, it was



located to the side the Scout Hut. It had to be taken down in 2012 because it was rotten and very dangerous. We now have plans ready for the proposed new building to replace the Scout and already demolished footballers hut. This has been a long time in preparation and was one of the original 2007

Parish Plan main initiatives. We are now looking for quotes and then we will start looking for funding. This is a combined Parish Council and Scout project which will benefit the community in general.
