Power Cuts

Western Power has now been renamed as the National Grid. They have a Priority Service Register that provides extra help and additional support during a power cut for elderly, very ill or disabled people, or those who rely on power for medical equipment. While power cuts can still happen, they will do everything they can to keep you connected.

You can also register for this service by telephone via your energy supplier see your electricity bill. They will register you and let the National Grid know as well.

It's free to register they will need you name, address, telephone number, details of any electrically dependent equipment. And you can register directly to the National Grid by calling 0800 096 3080. They will also keep you up-dated by text during a power cut.

Customers can register with them for the following reasons:

- elderly customers
- you keep medicine in the fridge
- learning disabilities
- sight loss
- · mental health issues
- wheelchair use/mobility
- children under five
- you have just come out of hospital
- reliance on medical equipment
- hearing loss.
