### Major Planning Application Again

A further planning application has been submitted by the Marshall Way travellers. The application number is S23/2004 and is for a change of use from agricultural land to use as a residential caravan site for 1 gypsy / traveller family group on 7 pitches,



comprising of 10 touring caravans and 10 static caravans, erection of 10 utility buildings and 7 stable blocks with ancillary paddock land; formation of new access, hard-standing for parking and the installation of a package sewage treatment plant. This is a re-submission of S22/1022 Meadow View Marshall Way Foston Lincs NG32 2LQ.

Once again the Parish Council, would like to hear your views which are very important, on this proposed development within the village as soon as possible. All representations have to be in by the 15<sup>th</sup> of December and the Parish Council will need time to collate resident's views beforehand. So we will send in the Parish Council's representation once we have heard back from Foston residents. So, to have your views included in the Parish Council's representation to South Kesteven District Council we will need them by 8<sup>th</sup> December.

### New Wheelie Bins

We have all been delivered, a nice new bin by South Kesteven District Council (SKDC). SKDC are working with other Councils in Lincolnshire to boost the quality and quantity of paper and cardboard materials recycled within our county.



All clean, dry, quality paper and cardboard collected for the purple-lidded bins has to be kept separate from other waste. It is sent to a dedicated paper mill in Kings Lynn. The paper mill is operated by Lincolnshire County Council's contractor and these collections commence monthly on the 6<sup>th</sup> February.

### Callconnect

The Callconnect bus is an on-request local bus service and it has been running for about 15 years in Foston. It serves hamlets, villages and market towns throughout Lincolnshire and neighbouring counties with a flexible booking system. They offer passengers the flexibility to connect to their local communities and other transport options in the area.



All Single rides on Callconnect are capped at £2. The mini bus service runs from Monday to Saturday for anyone & everyone.

It is free to register and you can book online by phone or by app. The service is flexible, and bookable with some timetabled services. It is easy to use with single, return & saver tickets available. Concessionary bus passes

are also accepted. You can book with as little as 1 hours' notice up to 7 days in advance.
