- Air Accident Investigation Branch investigation will be desktop based only, publication date of the report is currently unknown
- There is no reason why there should be flying over the village and there is signage in place at the Airfield that states there should not be any flying over the village.
- Several options are available as to the future location of the airfield to be considered once the report is published, these include moving the airfield which would have planning implications.
